



Summer 2021 Fellowship Opportunity in the Cryptocurrency Industry



Interconnected Justice

CoinMover is building a 21st century company: inclusive, global, and future-focused.

While traditional financial institutions and tech companies have posed their own sets of obstacles for entry, a new digital monetary system exists that can help change the career trajectory of many who have historically been left outside of the financial business sector: the cryptocurrency industry. Cryptocurrency by its very nature boasts financial inclusion and the democratization of global economics, attracting a wide variety of people from various nationalities, ethnicities, genders, etc., from around the world.

To that end, the founders of CoinMover are taking a leadership position in this emerging industry by providing access and mentorship to all segments of the population. Members of the BIPOC and the LGBT+ communities are encouraged to apply for a once in a lifetime opportunity: A 2021 Summer Fellowship at CoinMover's headquarters.

The following provides an overview of the Athari Collective Fellowship program in partnership with CoinMover and Interconnected Justice (ICJ).

How It Works

ICJ will identify and recruit a Summer Fellow who will be placed at CoinMover. Over the course of 6 weeks under the tutelage of the company's executive team, the Fellow will gain a cursory understanding of the key facets of the cryptocurrency industry through hands-on experience and direct mentorship from senior officers. This experience will yield useful tactical experience and a credible building block on his/her/their resume.

The CoinMover Summer Fellowship experience

- is on site at CoinMover located in Lynn, MA, 30 minutes outside of Boston
- runs from June 28th -August 6
- is composed of 3-weeks of a panoramic overview of the core disciplines of technology, finance, operations, and marketing, and 3-weeks of an intensive project anchored in the area of the Fellowship's choice
- will conclude with a presentation of the final project in an open forum on the Clubhouse social media network
- provides a stipend of \$4,000

Criteria for application

- The candidate must
 - Be entering their senior year of college in September '21, be a college graduate of the class of '21 or a current or incoming graduate student



- have a demonstrated interest in financial services and technology
- demonstrate the ability to work proactively
- be a problem solver who works well in groups
- have strong oral and written communication skills
- be available to participate for the entire duration of the program

Application elements

- A cover letter (maximum 500 words) explaining the reasons for his/her/their interest in this Fellowship and how he /she/they hope to use the knowledge acquired
- Final candidates must provide a letter of recommendation from any of the following sources: academic, personal, professional

ICJ selection process

1. ICJ will review the application packages
2. ICJ will choose the top candidates for interviews, plus verify credentials and recommendations
3. ICJ will identify 2 two of the candidates to be presented to CoinMover for a final selection.
